Unsafe sleep environment is the leading cause of non-natural deaths among children under the age of 1 in Dallas County

78%

Not sleeping in crib

59%

Sleeping on same surface as caregiver

41%

Placed to sleep on stomach

43%

Of infants who died while sharing a bed with a caregiver/sibling, had a crib present in the home.

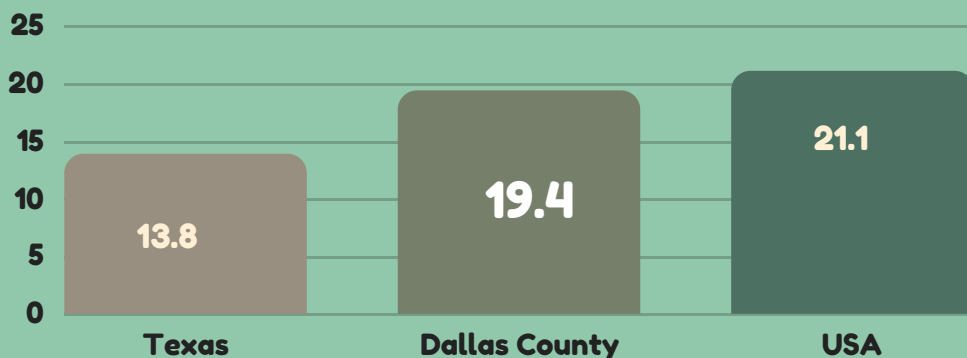
American Academy of Pediatrics recommends:

- An infant placed on their back
- On a firm sleep surface in an empty crib or bassinet
- With a tight fitted sheet
- Without blankets, pillows, crib bumpers, and soft toys

An infant in Dallas County is 1.4X more likely to die due to unsafe sleep than in the state of Texas.
